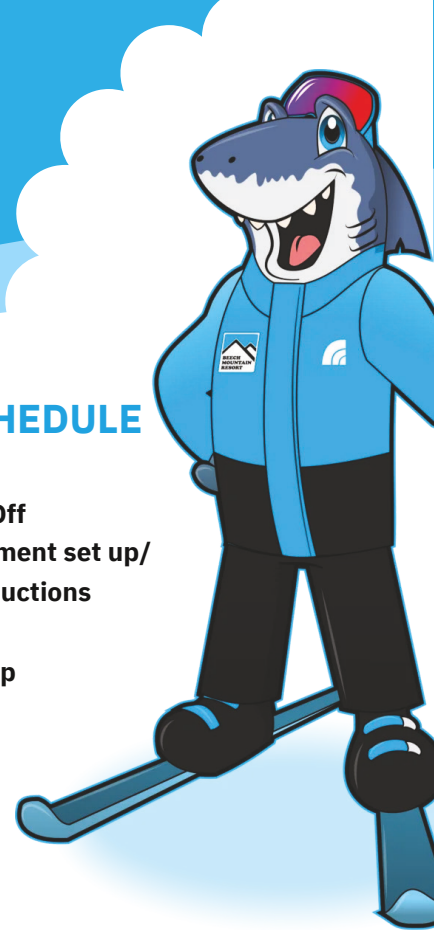

WHAT DOES THE PROGRAM OFFER?

The program includes: rental equipment, slope pass, all-day instruction, and lunch.

HOW DO I REGISTER?

Save time and guarantee your spot by registering online before arrival! If available, we can book at the Ski and Ride School front desk, but these programs regularly sell out. Hence, we recommend registering online before arrival.

HOW SHOULD I DRESS MY CHILD, AND WHAT SHOULD I BRING?

When dressing your child in the morning, it's good to start with a thin base layer - long johns or thermals. Layer according to the weather with a waterproof jacket and pants. Bring a winter hat and neck warmer if the temperatures look cold. All children are required to wear gloves whenever they are on the snow. Children should only wear one pair of socks, preferably ski socks, as they keep your kid's feet drier and warmer. Remember, goggles or sunglasses! Remember to apply sunscreen! We will not offer snacks outside of lunch, but feel free to pack some if you think your child might get hungry. You can also provide a water bottle to ensure your child is hydrated.

TRAXX (SKI) PROGRAM

If you have already purchased online, please proceed to the Traxx office at the end of the Ski and Ride School building. Our Ski and Ride School building is next to the Play Yard Slope, closest to Parking Lot 1. You'll enter Traxx through the glass door at the top of the stairs, above the restrooms and locker room. A Traxx supervisor will be waiting to welcome you into the program.

BURTON LEARN TO RIDE (SNOWBOARD) PROGRAM

Our Ski and Ride School building is next to the Play Yard Slope, closest to Parking Lot 1. If you have already purchased online, please proceed to the stairwell between the ski rental entrance and the ski rental exit. This stairwell goes up to the Burton Learn to ride school. There is a Burton

Learn to Ride Sign at the bottom of the stairs. A supervisor will be waiting to welcome you into the program.
